NOTIFICATION

The 15th May 1991

No. TAD/BC/432/88/47. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 13 of the Assam Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) Act, 1978 (Assam Act XII of 1979), the Governor of Assam is pleased to make the following amendments

to the Assam Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of Vacancies in Services and Posts) Rules, 1983, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules, namely:—

1. Short title, commencement and application:

- (i) These Rules may be called the Assam Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Reservation of vacancies in Services and Posts) (Amendment) Rules, 1991.
- (ii) They shall come into force on the date of issue of this notification.
- (iii) These Rules shall apply to whole of the State of Assam.

2. Amendment of Rule 3(1) (a):

In the Principal Rules, the existing Sub Rule (1) (a) shall be substituted by the following:—

u IN CASE OF SCHEDULED CASTE CANDIDATES:—
Only the Deputy Commissioners of the concerned districts of which the candidate is a resident is authorised to grant Scheduled Caste Certificate. The Deputy Commissioners may hold enquiry through their Sub-Divisional Officers and other functionaries and may also obtain such assistance as they deem proper from the members of the Advisory Council for Welfare of Scheduled Caste, Chairman of the Sub-Divisional Scheduled Caste Development Board, President and Vice President of the Asom Anusuchit Jati Parishad and the President of the different District and Sub-Divisional level Asom Anusuchit Jati Parishad.

Provided that while making any enquiry following aspect in addition to other relevant matters shall be taken into consideration:—

- (a) The caste of person does not change by marriage.
- (b) The offspring of a couple where one of the spouses belongs to S. C. does not automatically belongs to S. C. excepting that the offspring is brought up in the Social Customs and environment of the S. C. Community and has been accepted as such by the community.

(c) Where the Surname of the person is not same as one usually used by S. C. Community, verification of surname of the ancestors will be necessary.

(d) No person who professes a religion other than the Hindu or the Sikh religion shall be deemed to be a member of the Scheduled Caste.)

3. Amendment of Rules 3(2):

In the Principal Rules 3(2) in between the first two words "The" and "Certificate" the word "Scheduled Tribe" will be inserted.
